

WEALD BOUNCY CASTLES TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF HIRE - SUMO

- The site should be cleared of any hazards, eg. glass, stones etc. and the sides must have a clearance of at least 2 metres from any property and/or spectators.
- The mats will be placed in accordance with the manufacturers instructions. The equipment must remain in this position whilst being used. Do not place anything else on or near the mats (except for the competitors).
- The Sumo suits, headgear and mats (the equipment) must not be used or left out in wet conditions. The equipment should be towel dried before use after wet conditions. If the equipment is moved due to weather conditions etc. it must be placed in the same position before recommencing.
- **The equipment must be supervised at all times by an adult (over 18 years old) and any boisterous behaviour and acrobatics stopped immediately. Do not allow anybody to enter the play area other than the two competitors whilst the game is being played.**
- Do not exceed the maximum number of TWO competitors at any one time per mat. Do not allow a mix of children of different sizes and never mix children and adults at the same time. Childrens suits only to be used by children (see age restriction below).

- Shoes, jewellery, spectacles, sharp objects or anything likely to cause injury to users or damage to equipment should be removed prior to commencement. ABSOLUTELY NO CIGARETTES, FOOD (INCLUDING GUM) OR DRINK TO BE TAKEN ONTO THE MAT AREA. Persons under the influence of Drink or Drugs should not be allowed to use the equipment.
- Any damage to equipment caused by its misuse or neglect, or loss due to the equipment being handed over to non-authorized persons shall deem the Hirer/Controller liable for full repair or replacement costs in addition to any loss of business as a result of that damage.
- The equipment should be in a clean state when collected. Weald Bouncy Castles reserve the right to charge a cleaning fee (minimum of £25.00) if in their opinion the equipment is in an unsatisfactory condition when collected.
- It is advisable to ensure that no one with any history of back or neck problems use the equipment. Anyone with a known history that may be affected by using the equipment should refrain from doing so (eg. pregnancy, heart conditions etc). Active play is not without risk or injury. Parents or guardians are deemed to have acknowledged this risk by allowing children to use the equipment.
- An accident book is available and any injury to a participant should be notified to the operator, recorded therein and signed by the injured person or their representative.
- If supplied with a "Rules of Use" card (see below*) it must be obeyed at all times.
