



### WEALD BOUNCY CASTLES TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF HIRE

- The site should be cleared of any hazards, eg. glass, stones etc. and the open sides of the inflatable should be well cushioned against possible contact with sharp objects.
- The inflatable will be erected and anchored in accordance with the manufacturers instructions. The inflatable must NOT be moved or tampered with once erected. If pegs or sandbags are used be aware of possible trip hazards that may exist.
- The inflatable should not be used in high winds or wet conditions in contravention of the manufacturers guidelines. The inflatable bed should be towel dried before use after wet conditions.
- The RCD (Residual Current Device) breaker must be used at all times. All electrical equipment is fully tested within the Health & Safety guidelines by a qualified tester. NO PERSONS SHALL INTERFERE WITH THE ELECTRICAL EQUIPMENT. The blower unit ( and generator if used) must not be interfered with unless instructed to do so. Do not obstruct the air intakes.
- **The inflatable must be supervised at all times by an adult (over 18 years old) and any boisterous behaviour and acrobatics stopped immediately. DO NOT ALLOW ANYONE TO SIT ON THE SIDES NOR CLIMB, SWING, SLIDE OR HANG FROM THE WALLS AND/OR BEAMS OF THE INFLATABLE.**
- Do not exceed the manufacturers recommended age or numbers of persons using the inflatable. Do not allow a mix of children of different sizes and never mix children and adults on the inflatable at the same time.

- Shoes, jewellery, spectacles, sharp objects or anything likely to cause injury to users or damage to equipment should be removed prior to commencement. ABSOLUTELY NO CIGARETTES, FOOD OR DRINK (INCLUDING GUM) TO BE TAKEN ONTO THE INFLATABLE. Persons under the influence of Drink or Drugs should not be allowed to use the inflatable.
- In the event of deflation of the inflatable for any reason it should be evacuated immediately to prevent injury to users or damage to the equipment.
- Any damage to equipment caused by its misuse or neglect, or loss due to the equipment being handed over to non-authorized persons shall deem the Hirer/Controller liable for full repair or replacement costs in addition to any loss of business as a result of that damage.
- The inflatable should be in a clean state when collected. Weald Bouncy Castles reserve the right to charge a cleaning fee (minimum of £25.00) if in their opinion the inflatable is in an unsatisfactory condition when collected.
- It is advisable to ensure that no one with any history of back or neck problems use the inflatable. Anyone with a known history that may be affected by using the inflatable should refrain from doing so (eg. pregnancy, heart conditions etc). Active play is not without risk or injury. Parents or guardians are deemed to have acknowledged this risk by allowing children onto the inflatable.
- An accident book is available and any injury to a participant should be notified to the operator, recorded therein and signed by the injured person or their representative.
- If supplied with a "Rules of Use" card (see below\*) it must be obeyed at all times.
